Following a committee meeting on Sunday 24<sup>th</sup> May we have decided to put the next shoot on as per the fixture list on June 7<sup>th</sup>. In line with government guidelines and CPSA recommendations it will be quite different to what we have been used to so please take note of the following:

It will be for members only – no guests

It will be a 50-bird practice shoot – no prizes

Unfortunately, buggies will not be available for the less mobile

There will be no burger van so please bring your own refreshments

You will shoot in squads of four (please create your own squad if possible) with the first squad going out at 9.30 and then in 10-minute intervals after that. All on a first come, first served basis.

Once you have created a squad please ring Helen on 01206 841477 to book your time out.

If you have difficulty creating a squad, you may be able to tie up with others on the club Facebook page. Failing that Helen may be able to help you but only as a last resort please.

You will start shooting from Stand No1 by the office and shoot the stands in numerical order

We would prefer payment in advance by BACS to Sort code 09-01-51, Acc' No 28729309 – Colchester Garrison Clay Pigeon Club. Failing that one payment in cash on the day for the correct amount for the squad. Cartridges will still be available at £5.50 per box, again paid for in advance or correct money on the day.

Sanitiser will be at each stand so please use it before and after using the remotes.

## **General Notes:**

If you have any doubts about your own health, please stay at home.

Please arrive no more than 15 minutes before your time slot.

Only one from each squad to the office when booking in.

If the squads are not formed from a single Household, Social distancing is to be maintained within that squad throughout the shoot.

Please pick up any empty cartridge cases before leaving the stand.

Please ensure you bin any discarded PPE before leaving, gloves masks etc.

No Sharing of guns/Equipment/Cartridges unless between Household Groups.

Please keep to the 2mt social distancing rules and ground markers and stay alert.

We hope you will support us and enjoy the day and with the continued easing of the lockdown rules we hope it will not be too long before we can resume normal service!
